What a remarkable year it has been for the D41Kids Foundation!

Together with you, we have positively impacted the lives of over 700 families and children in our community. From providing free books through our Dolly Parton Imagination Library affiliate to empowering children to take the stage in our Summer Theater Program, your support has inspired our community's youth to dream big.

Established in January 2020, D41Kids initially aimed to provide opportunities and financial support for children in our district. However, as the pandemic unfolded, we quickly pivoted to address more immediate needs. We've helped families keep a roof over their heads, put food on the table, and remain dedicated to our original mission. All thanks to YOU!

As you read on, you'll discover that the strength of D41Kids Foundation lies in the passion and support of our donors and volunteers. We are immensely grateful for your contributions, and we look forward to expanding our reach and impact to better serve our children.

Mission

To strengthen public education in D41 through advocacy for, and partnership and investment in initiatives that promote equity, excellence, enhance student outcomes, and foster lifelong learning.

Impact (Since 2020)

- **450** children (ages 0-5) enrolled in our DPIL affiliate
- 93 children (grades K-8) participated in the Summer Theater production
- 61 8th graders participated in our Future GBW Freshman Bundles fundraiser
- Hundreds of families received food subsidies (\$14,500)
- **25** families received rental assistance (\$20,000)
- Supported 2 sister nonprofits, Supplies for Success and Karen's Closet, with funding for school supplies and winter outerwear (\$2,000)
- Financially backed the Glen Ellyn Children's Resource Center summer program for at-risk children (\$1,000)

Our Work

At our founding in 2020, D41Kids Foundation began operation under the umbrella of Partnership for Educational Progress (PEP) who expertly managed the administrative requirements so that the Foundation could focus on delivering services to our D41 families. The enormous impact of the work of the foundation during that time culminated in our ability to establish the D41 Kids Foundation as its own 501(c)3, effective as of July 1, 2022. As a result, much of the behind the scenes work of the Foundation in the latter half of 2022 was focused on creating a strong operational foundation on which to grow. Setting up financials, integrating donor management software, securing appropriate insurance and financial

- DPIL To date, we have enrolled 450 children (ages 0-5) in our Dolly Parton Imagination Library affiliate. For just \$27 a year, each child receives a new, age-appropriate book every month, fostering a love of reading and building essential literacy skills.
- Summer Theater Program Open to all district children in grades K-8, our no-cut program offers the chance to participate in a theatrical musical production. Children develop a strong sense of self, discover new talents, and learn essential collaboration skills all while having fun!



- **Future GBW Freshman Bundles** To celebrate our 8th-grade students' achievements and upcoming high school journey, we provide yard signs and high school t-shirts to participating families.
- **Community Outreach** By maintaining close communication with school social workers and administrators, we identify and assist families in crisis.

Tucker's Tribe, 3 Soap Parties, and A Very Generous Supporter

Glen Ellyn resident Christine Pope Guare is the mother of three boys, one of whom has an Autism Spectrum Disorder. Because of the outstanding support her son has received from the staff and teachers of District 41, Christine and "Tucker's Tribe," an extended family of people who are dedicated to helping Tucker grow and thrive, wanted to find a way to give back to the district.

"Tucker is somehow thriving," Christine explains. "We take each moment in a dose, each day, each month. Sometimes you step forward, back and to the side ... but we move forward." Christine partnered with her friend Hilary Bergamini, owner of The Bar Above, and held several "soap parties," raising

\$2,182.80 and donating those proceeds to D41 Kids Foundation. She says, "It feels good to give back to our own community."







In line with our mission to invest in initiatives that promote equity, excellence, enhance student outcomes, and foster lifelong learning, the D41 Kids Foundation is excited to announce that two long-standing programs that have supported our community's children will be joining D41Kids Foundation in 2023:

- Supplies for Success: This program raises funds to provide essential school supplies for
 children in need within our community. With 20.5% of District 41's 3,500 students qualifying as
 low-income, Supplies for Success aims to level the playing field. By offering a Supplies 4 Success
 Kit, complete with an assembled school supply kit and backpack, we ensure that every child
 starts the school year on the right foot, paving the way for educational success and a brighter
 future for the Glen Ellyn area.
- **Karen's Closet:** Karen's Closet is dedicated to providing winter outerwear for children whose families may struggle to afford proper cold-weather gear. Every year, we witness numerous families in our community unable to purchase coats, snow pants, boots, gloves, and hats for their children. Karen's Closet aims to keep hundreds of students healthy, safe, and warm throughout the challenging Midwestern winters by distributing essential winter attire.
- Community Outreach: This program responds to the immediate needs of our District 41 families. Through close communication with representatives in each school, D41 Kids Foundation is ready to provide financial support to families in crisis. In addition, this program coordinates Holiday Sharing, a program that helps to ensure our more vulnerable families receives toys, books, and groceries for the holidays.
